PETER AND PAUL LANE**; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX OF THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. WAS READ THE SECOND TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MR. RAY THE RULES OF COUNCIL WERE SUSPENDED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.

THE ORDINANCE WAS THEN PLACED UPON ITS PASSAGE AND PASSED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.

**MR. BROWN:** "IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE THAT BEGS OUR ATTENTION ON THE AGENDA? MR. RAY?"

**MR. RAY:** "I JUST WANT TO THANK COUNCIL AND THE CLERKS AND THE MAYORS OFFICE AND ALL OF OUR STAFF FOR THEIR COOPERATION LAST WEEK FOR THE PLANNING OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMITTEE MEETING AND MEMBERS. I THINK IT WAS A SUCCESS IN GETTING OUT INFORMATION. ALSO, I JUST RECEIVED A MESSAGE, SOME PEOPLE MAY KNOW THIS ALREADY, BUT APPARENTLY IN THE VINDICATOR AT 4:52 P.M., IT SAYS THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SAID IT WILL NOT APPROVE ANY ADDITIONAL BRINE INJECTION WELL PERMITS UNTIL IT COMPLETES AN INJECTION WELL REPORT. SO, I THINK THEIR HEARING OUR VOICES. WE WILL CONTINUE TO DISSEMINATE AS MUCH INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE AND SPREAD THE WORD AS WE CAN. JUST THANKS FOR YOUR COOPERATION TO THE CITIZENS."

**MR. BROWN:** "MAYOR?"

**MAYOR SAMMARONE:** “JUST TO CONTINUE WITH WHAT COUNCILMAN RAY SAID, AT THE TIME, WE DIDN’T KNOW WHAT WAS GOING TO HAPPEN. BUT, BECAUSE OF WHAT WE DID AS A GROUP WITH THE RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MORATORIUM ON DRILLING, THEN THE FOLLOW-UP WITH THE MEETING THE UTILITY COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL, BASED ON WHAT MR. RAY JUST SAID, AND I DIDN’T SEE THE PAPER OR HEAR ABOUT IT, BECAUSE OF WHAT WE DID, BECAUSE NO ONE ELSE WOULD SAY ANYTHING, REPRESENTATIVE HAGAN WAS TRYING TO GET THE GOVERNOR TO MAKE SOME DECISIONS ON A MORATORIUM. I FEEL, AND WHAT I’VE HEARD FROM PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNITY, BECAUSE OF WHAT WE DID AS A GROUP WITH THE RESOLUTION AND THE UTILITY COMMITTEE MEETING, WE GOT THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE AND THE PEOPLE AT THE STATE LEVEL TO DO SOMETHING WITH THIS DRILLING. IT LOOKS LIKE THEY FOUND OUT THAT THERE ARE SOME PROBLEMS IF THEY MADE THOSE KINDS OF DECISIONS. HOPEFULLY THEY WILL CONTINUE TO LOOK AT IT AND WHATEVER THE OTHER PROBLEMS ARE, THEY WILL CORRECT THOSE TOO BEFORE THEY DECIDE TO DRILL ANYMORE. BUT, AGAIN, AS MIKE SAID IN THANKING EVERYBODY, THE ADMINISTRATION WOULD LIKE TO THANK YOU ALSO.”

**MR BROWN:** “ABSOLUTELY, THAT’S GOOD TEAMWORK. I WOULD ALSO LIKE TO THANK, BEFORE WE GO, MS. JENAE WARD, FOR COMING OUT. THIS YOUNG LADY’S BEEN COURAGEOUS, A COMMUNITY ACTIVIST. I LOOK FOR SOME BIG AND BRIGHTER THINGS FOR HER IN THE FUTURE; BECAUSE I THINK WERE GOING TO HAVE TO HAVE MORE YOUTH INVOLVED IN OUR GOVERNMENT TO KEEP OUR MOVEMENTS GOING, ESPECIALLY WITH THESE TECHNOLOGY CHANGES THAT WE HAVE. I ALSO WANT TO THANK THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMITTEE. WE SAT THROUGH THERE, BUT I THINK IT WAS WELL NEEDED FOR THE COMMUNITY TO HEAR FROM THOSE VARIOUS AGENCIES BUT ALSO TO SEE THAT YOUNGSTOWN CITY COUNCIL AND THE ADMINISTRATION WERE SERIOUS ABOUT THE SAFETY OF THIS COMMUNITY. AND ALSO, I WANT TO LASTLY ASK FOR THOSE MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL AND THE MAYOR FOR THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE MYCAP SUPPORT LETTER TO THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE. I WEAR MANY HATS, AND I HAVE TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY EVERY TIME I HAVE THE CHANCE TO THANK THOSE WHO WILL HELP CONTINUE MOVING THIS COMMUNITY FORWARD. IS THERE AN ADJOURNMENT?”

**MRS. TARPLEY:** “I’D LIKE TO MAKE A MOTION TO ADJOURN.”

**MR. SWIERZ:** “SECOND.”
